Brief Introduction: Public Health Emergency Ending

- The federal Public Health Emergency (PHE) and Major Disaster Declaration (MDD) for COVID-19 will end on May 11, 2023
- This will end the temporary, but significant, changes made to Medicaid enrollment and eligibility rules, as well as additional pandemic-specific flexibilities
